

SUPER CREATOR AGREEMENT

LiveStage Inc.

Introduction

This Agreement governs a registered LiveStage user's ("Creator," "Super Creator") participation in the Super Subscription monetization program. "Creator" refers equally to photographers and models on LiveStage, regardless of their role in the creative process. By joining the program, the Creator agrees to these terms in full by checking the consent box when applying to activate the status.

1. Is Super Creator Right for You

Super Creator is a high-impact monetization tool built for photographers and models who are ready to actively promote their presence on LiveStage through their own audience on outside platforms — Instagram, TikTok, YouTube, and other established channels — and turn that audience into paying super-subscribers on LiveStage.

Active promotion looks like: regular Instagram Stories and posts announcing your live shoots and exclusive LiveStage content; short-form videos or TikTok Lives inviting your audience to subscribe; shoutouts to LiveStage in your YouTube bio or content; direct outreach and personal invites to your existing audience.

Super Creator is built for Creators with a proven track record: at least two private LiveShoots hosted on LiveStage, each with 10 or more paying participants, and strong participant ratings (LiveShoot Comments). Photographers should also have experience running offline group or in-person photo workshops on a regular basis. For models, the equivalent is a track record of regularly participating in offline photo shoots — solo or group — with professional photographers.

We're also looking for Creators with a positive reputation in their field.

Super Creator is designed for Creators who are ready and able to drive that kind of audience — it's a tool for people who know how to work their network and their following.

LiveStage reserves the right to decline or not approve a Super Creator application without providing a reason. We take this responsibility seriously and won't use it lightly.

2. What You Get

Once approved, a Super Creator gets:

- the ability to launch a paid subscription for LiveStage users (starting at \$19.99/month; as you build experience, your subscription price can be customized on request);

- a dedicated Finance section in your dashboard to manage your subscription and payouts;
- a locked, exclusive content section visible only to paying subscribers;
- an auto-created chat with every new subscriber in LiveStage's in-app messenger, kicked off with a welcome message from you;
- fast payouts on everything you earn through LiveStage.

3. Your Obligations on LiveStage

As a Super Creator, you agree to:

- host at least 3–4 short live shoots (7–10 minutes) per calendar month, exclusively for your subscribers. “Month” is applied reasonably and in good faith — minor scheduling drift isn't a violation;
- get a grace period for legitimate reasons (illness, force majeure, and similar circumstances) during which missing the monthly minimum won't count as a violation — as long as you notify both LiveStage and your active super-subscribers;
- keep these live shoots instant or scheduled, but never structured as private paid events — they're quick, in-the-moment highlights from your regular shoots, not a separate ticketed product;
- make sure your live shoots for super-subscribers are their own distinct experience — not a repeat or overlap of your other paid offerings. Monetizing the same content twice (as a standalone paid event and again as a subscriber add-on) isn't allowed;
- stay engaged with your subscribers in your 1:1 chats. This is a good-faith commitment rather than a fixed quota — but a pattern of substantiated subscriber complaints about being unresponsive can be treated as a violation;
- understand that failing to meet the obligations in this section may result in losing your Super Creator status;
- if something comes up that keeps you from meeting these obligations, reach out to your active super-subscribers directly yourself. Because subscribing and unsubscribing are individual actions each subscriber takes through the App Store or Google Play, LiveStage has no way to pause a subscription on our end — if a temporary break is needed, subscribers will need to cancel and re-subscribe on their own.

4. Growing Your Audience Off LiveStage

As a Super Creator, you actively bring your own following on Instagram, TikTok, YouTube, and other established platforms to LiveStage — along with direct email outreach and personal invites to your existing audience. Super Creator status is meant for Creators who use LiveStage as a monetization channel for the audience they've already built elsewhere, not solely as a way to tap into LiveStage's existing user base.

5. Content Guidelines

LiveStage prohibits sexually explicit or pornographic content — meaning explicit depictions of sexual organs or sexual activity intended to arouse. LiveStage is a platform for artistic photography content.

We also prohibit any content or activity associated with sexually exploitative conduct, offering sexual services in exchange for compensation, and any content that violates App Store or Google Play policies.

6. Term, Termination, and Loss of Status

This Agreement runs indefinitely from the date your Super Creator status is activated.

If you violate the terms of this Agreement, LiveStage will notify you through the app's in-app messenger.

If your Super Creator status is lost, the related functionality — accepting new subscriptions, giving new users access to your locked content, and so on — will no longer be available to you within the app.

LiveStage follows content moderation principles aligned with Apple App Store and Google Play policies, and expects the same from everyone in the Super Creator program.

7. Closing Notes

We see Super Creator as a partnership — a shared path toward growing and monetizing your talent. We're in this for the long run and we're always open to talking directly with you about anything related to this program.

LiveStage may update this Agreement from time to time as the platform and the Super Creator program evolve; the current version is always available on the LiveStage website. Continuing to use your Super Creator status after an update is published means you accept the new version.
